

About College of Horticulture & Forestry

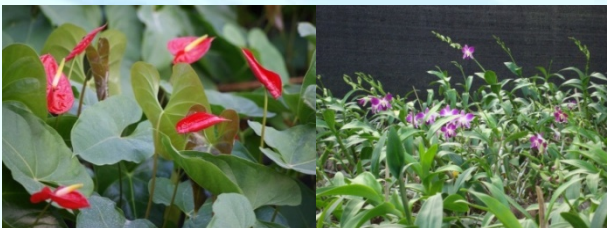
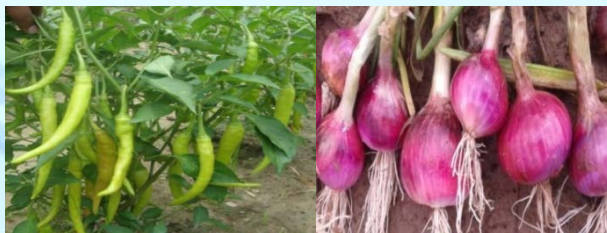
The College of Horticulture and Forestry was established at Pasighat in the East Siang District of Arunachal Pradesh on the 7th of March, 2001. Presently, the College is running three Undergraduate degree programmes namely, Horticulture, Forestry and Agriculture besides PG and Ph D Programme. College has broad mandates of research and extension. So far the college has completed 17 externally funded research projects and more than 23 research projects are running in the college. The college along with its KVK East Siang is actively engaged in various extension activities like *kisan mela*, Arunachal citrus show, horti expo, agri expo every year to encourage growers of Arunachal Pradesh

Location

The College campus is located in the foothills of eastern Himalayas on the bank of mighty river Siang, and is approximately 3 km away from Pasighat town towards North West direction. It is situated at 28^o 06' N latitude and 95^o 23' longitudes at an elevation of 157 msl. It is approximately 600 km from Guwahati.
